

INDEPENDENT CHURCH LEAGUE
Volleyball Meeting/Registration
October 22, 2007

League President, Steve Carlsberg opened the meeting with prayer.

Steve then reminded everyone that Eldon is the one who will be in charge and running things.

Important dates were given:

October 29th - 7:00 Rules meeting at Olympia Christian School
November 5th - Season begins
December 18th-January 6th - Holiday break
January 7th - Season continues

Game time will be 6:30, 7:15, 8:00, 8:45.

Grace period will be 10 minutes for first game, 5 minutes for second game and after 20 minutes all games will be forfeited.

All wins/losses are to be reported on the website.

All games will be played with rally scoring to 21 points.

Tom Sloan then came up and gave an overview of how to report scores on the website. He also answered any other questions concerning the website.

Steve then reminded everyone of what was needed for registration following the meeting: Registration form, roster (final rosters will be due by December 9th), waiver forms signed by every player, and background check forms completed and turned in if necessary.

Facilities were then discussed. The facilities we will have this year are Olympia Christian School, Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Grace Community Covenant Church, and Community Christian Academy.

A Division will play at Good Shepherd.

B & D Division will play at Community Christian Academy.

C Division will play at Grace Community Covenant Church.

E Division will play at Olympia Christian School.

Steve reminded everyone how important it is that we treat these facilities as our own and with respect. He also reminded everyone how important it is for all children to be supervised by someone other than a player.

Budget information was then shared.

Eldon then reviewed some basic rules. There was also a discussion on the pros and cons of having a pre-season and then placing teams in divisions. It was decided that we teams would be placed in their respective divisions and then after two weeks if changes needed to be made they would be.

Eldon also shared that if the right amount of teams signed up we could go to having only three games a night and if so the games would be an hour long and would be at 6:30, 7:30 and 8:30.

Eldon then explained how the refereeing would work for both types of schedules.

If 3 games a night those playing the 7:30 game would referee both the 6:30 and 8:30 games. The players from the 6:30 game would referee the 7:30 game. Those playing the 8:30 game would not referee that night.

If 4 games a night the format would be:

Play 6:30 game - referee 7:15 game

Play 7:15 game - referee 6:30 game

Play 8:00 game - referee 8:45 game

Play 8:45 game - referee 8:00 game

Meeting ended with a reminder for all to attend the Rules Meeting next Monday, October 22, 2007 at Olympia Christian School at 7:00.

Everyone was then dismissed to register their teams.
