- A. Opening prayer - Steve Carlsberg
- B. Introduction of Board Members - Those present were Steve Carlsberg, Eldon Witsey, Tom Sloan and Rhonda Tevis.
- C. Old Business
1. Last year we had 27 coed teams with 4 divisions.
  2. Two locations - Olympia Christian School and Good Shepherd Lutheran Church
  3. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place trophies were given out for each division.
  4. No major problems last year and just reminder for this year that all children must be supervised, even if only going to the bathroom. Did have someone smoking in the bathrooms and this was addressed.
  5. Donations were made to both facilities last year as in previous years for use of their facilities.
  6. Suggestions for next year:
    - Better object for referees to stand on besides a chair
    - Referees being diligent about starting games on time
- D. New Business - Eldon resided over this part of the meeting.
1. Next meeting will be Monday, October 22, 2007 at 7:00 pm at College Street Christian Church. You will need to bring completed registration form, waiver signed by each player/guardian for under 18 year old players and the \$100.00 fee.
  2. Season dates - November 5, 2007 to February 26, 2008 with the weeks between December 18, 2007 to January 6, 2008 off.
  3. Reminder that kids must be supervised at all times by non-participating party. No children unsupervised even to go to the bathroom.

F. Facilities Discussion - Steve presided over this.

1. Have for sure Olympia Christian School
2. Probably have Good Shepherd Lutheran Church
3. Some new names of churches to contact were given:
  - New Bridge
  - Faith Lutheran Church
  - Grace Community Church
  - Northwest Christian High School
4. Another possibility only if absolutely necessary is The Valley Health Club. The cost may not make it worth going there.

G. Rules Discussion - Eldon presided over this.

1. Score cards would be at the facilities.
2. Game times are 6:30, 7:15, 8:00, and 8:45.
3. 4-5 Divisions, to be determined by how many courts we get
4. 10 teams per division
5. Officiating times explained - example: You play at 7:15 you must provide two referees for the 6:30 game. If you play the 6:30 game you must provide two referees for the 7:15 game. Same concept for the 8:00 and 8:45 games (play for one, officiate at the other one).
6. The consequences if you do not provide two players to officiate:
  - a. Warning
  - b. Loss of one game for your team
  - c. Loss of three games for your team
7. No jump serves except for A division.
8. Maximum of 6 players with a minimum of 2 female players at all times. Must have a minimum of 5 to play.
9. Each team allowed one time out per game. Time out is for one minute.
10. Play to 21 with rally scoring for entire game. Must win by 2.
11. USVA rules apply except for our select changes.
12. Except on serve the ball is playable off of the ceiling/beams but not off the walls. Basketball hoops are to be replayed if the ball hits them if player is there waiting for the ball, if no player there it is a dead ball.

13. Serves that hit the net and go over are playable. Serves that hit the ceiling are dead balls.

14. Purpose of playing is for fellowship with other believers. Be encouraging and have good attitudes. Have FUN!

Mark Tevis moved that we change the rule to allow play with a minimum of 4 players with at least two females. Second by Lori Sloan. Much discussion followed. Steve Carlsberg amended the motion to add that the roster must have a minimum of 6 players on it. Seconded by Troy ?. After further discussion the vote was taken. 17 yes votes to accept this rule change. 1 no vote.
